### Devotion

### Treasurer's Report

- We had more profit this year from the Pentathlon, despite fewer swimmers compared to last year. Our income was \$7,551 and expenses were \$2,580, for a profit of \$4,971.
- We have 100% of fees collected from parents for the first half.
- We have two bank accounts for the team. One account is used to pay the pool fees of \$10,000 per year. The second is a parents' account for fund raising, concessions, etc. The balance in the parents' account is currently \$6,304. The spending of the money in the parents' account is at our discretion as long as we meet financial obligations to the YMCA.
- Everyone should have received November statements in the mail.

### Coach's report

- The upcoming DCY meet is a relatively simple 1 day meet. We want to encourage swimmers to attend DCY, as they are a close friend to Sidney. We want to support them, just as they support our Pentathlon.
- **We will NOT be attending PCY as they were full and could not accept our entries. We will be adding a meet to the schedule, but are unsure yet as to which meet we will add. As soon as a decision is made, we will notify everyone.**
- Mid season changes may be made on team placement. The coaches will talk to parents before moving swimmers.
- Chase VanTilburgh won the high-point award for boys 9-10 at the SPY invitational.

### Second Chair/Administrative Coordinator Report

- We still need chairs for several committees. The biggest need is for the end of year banquet committee. Naomi will recruit from families that are not on any committees. Committee members will need to plan swimmers gifts, track RSVPs and payment, etc.
- We need people to sign up to work concessions at High School Meets on 1/2, 1/23, 2/13, 2/23. Each family needs to sign up for 1 date. You can sign up for 1/2 hour set up, 2 1/2 hours run concessions, and/or clean up afterward.

### Apparel Information- fees

- We are considering changing our supplier for apparel next year---maybe Castaway or Poco Loco
- In the process of forming an apparel committee toward end of year to make decisions
