Volunteer Areas

(check all you may be interested in)

Team Spirit Committee

Description: organizes fun things to do throughout the year such as a fun event (ex: pizza party) for the team to kick off the new season, poster-making night prior to swim meets, holiday events (goody bags or canned goods drive), etc.

Food Acquisition Committee

Description: Plans menu for home meets, assists concessions coordinator with set up and tear down.

Parent Pals Chair

Description: "Veteran" swim parents are matched with "new" swim parents to help them get acclimated to the swim team.

Spaghetti Dinner Committee

Description: Plan and help organize the annual Spaghetti dinner / game night. (Usually held in March)

Overnight Stays Chair

Description: Coordinate a group rate for out-of-town meets (for those that wish to stay in a hotel).

End-of-Season Banquet Committee

Description: Coordinate location/cost/catering and awards for swimmers. Help decide on coaches gifts, assist with set up and/or clean up.

Heat Sheet Ad Design Chair

Description: Coordinates personal ad sales for the Pentathlon Heat Sheet and assists with design and layout. Helps with copying and assembling the Heat Sheet and can also assist with sales of the Heat Sheet on Meet Day.

Swim Team Apparel Chair

Description: coordinates orders and delivery of swim team apparel from Ernest

Meet Workers

Description: *Timers*- needed at both home and away meets. Uses a stop watch to record all events. (Training provided) *Deck Runners* - Retrieves lane slips after each heat from timers/recorders and delivers to the computer team at home meets; *Clerk of Course* - helps get the younger swimmers (at home meets) lined up and ready for their events. Workers typically sign up for a specific shift (not the entire meet)

Officials

Description: officiate at home and away meets. Training required and provided.

Publicity Committee

Description: Submits regular articles to the Sidney Daily News about Individual and Team accomplishments.

Bulletin Board Committee

Description: Decorates the YMCA Swim Team BB with photos and info pertaining to the team. Usually done 2x a season.

Fundraiser Committee

Description: coordinates various fundraising activities.

Concessions Help

Description: Signs up to work a shift at home meets to help with concession sales.

Entry Scoring Committee

Description: enters timing data into Meet Manager software, prints final stats and award labels for the Computer Awards, at home meets, receive award labels from Computer Team and place on appropriate ribbons. Organize for distribution to team reps.
